CAPITAL INVESTMENT: FIRST & SECOND PARTY are the investing partners.
Both the parties hereto shall have the right and access to all books of accounts of the firm.

7. INTEREST & REMUNERATION:

A. INTERST: The necessary capital as well as further fund required for the purpose of partnership business shall be contributed or arranged exclusively by FIRST & SECOND PARTY from time to time, as per business requirement and the same shall bear simple interest at the rate offered by State Bank of India on the savings deposits in the concerned financial year or as may be prescribed by Section 40(b) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any modification or amendments thereto which may be in force in the relevant financial year; and all such interest amounts shall be credited to their current account with the firm on the closing day of every financial year.

B. REMUNERATIONS:

i. Both the partners shall be treated as working partners, for the purpose of remuneration, of the firm as defined in clause (b) of Section 40 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and shall be entitled to remuneration. The total remuneration paid or payable to both the working partners taken together shall not exceed the limits prescribed under the sub clause (v) of the Section 40 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any modification/amendments, thereto, or maybe relevant at that time, for this purpose. The total remuneration shall be shared by the working partners in the ratio of profit sharing as mentioned in this deed. The mode of calculating and quantum of such remuneration shall be as follows:-
