#### Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of PINE DEVELOPERS PRIVATE LIMITED, which comprise the Batance Sheet as at 31/03/2022, the Statement of Profit and Loss, for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

#### Auditor's Opinion

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid financial statements give the information required by the Act in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at 31/03/2022, and its Loss for the year ended on that date.

#### Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013.
