Sub: Allotment of a separate code No. under section 2-A of the Employees' Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provisions Act '52 to M/s. Ashiana Housing & Finance (India) Ltd.

Sir. Please refer to your letter No. AFIL/247/89-90 dated 14.1.90 on the subject mentioned above.

As desired a separate code No. BR/5927 is allotted to the establishment at Samastipur under section 2-A of the Employees' Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provisions Act '52 and accordingly, you are directed to deposit the provident fund, Family Pension Fund, E.D.L.I. dues and submit the statutory returns with effect from 01-3-90 in Bihar region.

Provident Fund contribution may please be deducted @ 6 1/8% upto dtd. 31.7.88 and @ 8.33% w.e.f. 01.8.1988 onwards, on the basic and dearness allowance (including cash value of the food concession if any), out of which 1% will be taken as Employees' Family Pension Fund and the contributions payable by the employer shall be equal to the employees contributions. Administrative charges is to be paid @ 0.37% and 0.65% w.e.f. 01.10.1986 on the total wages paid to the subscribers subject to minimum of Rs. 5/- per month. Provident Fund Contributions and administrative charges are required to be deposited in Employees' Provident Fund Account No. I & II respectively maintained in the State Bank of India, by the 15th of each following month to which it relates and family pension fund in account No. 'X' (Red challan). The employer has to pay every month to the D.L.I. fund @ 0.5% of the aggregate of the wages of the employees. The said amount is to be deposited to A/c No. 21 maintained by the State Bank of India.

The employer has to pay further every month to the D.L.I. Fund A/c No. 22 @ 0.1% of the Total monthly wages paid to the subscribers.

Statutory return in Form 12(R), 10, 5 etc. are to be submitted by 25th of the following month. It may please also be noted that damages are liable to be levied on all belated payments which may extend to 100% of the arrears as per the amended provisions of the Act with effect from 1st November '73.

Over and above, employers are required to furnish the particulars of ownership from 5-A in accordance with the provisions of para 36-A of the employees' Provident Fund and Family Pension Fund Scheme, 1952. Hence, you are directed to furnish the said Form in duplicate duly filled in by Registered Post.

In case of any change in the particulars of Form 5-A the intimation should be communicated to this office within 15 days of such change.

The required statutory forms will be supplied free of cost on requisition by this office. If necessary, you may contact the office of the Enforcement officer, J.S.R. (Samastipur).
