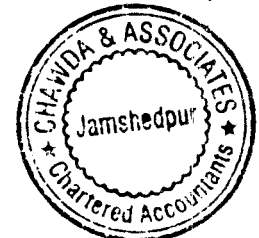
REPORT ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

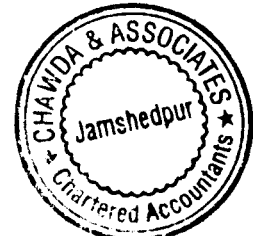

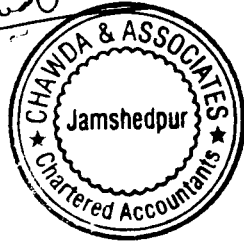

3. Depreciation

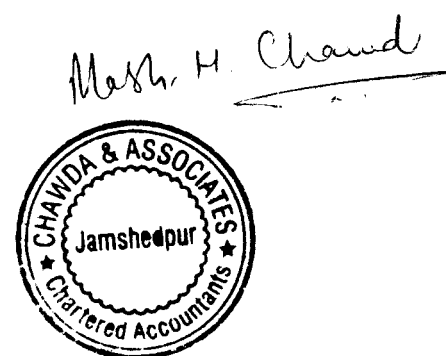
There are no Fixed Assets. Hence, no Depreciation is charged.
