## THE EXAMINATION

The **Indian School Certificate (Year-12) Examination** is in accordance with the 10 plus 2 scheme of school-education of the Kothari Education Commission and is taken after a 2-year course of study beyond the **Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (Year-10) Examination** or its equivalent.

## MEANING OF GRADES

### I. EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

Attainment in a subject is indicated by a grade, of which Grade 1 is the highest and Grade 9 the lowest; only Grades 1 to 8 are recorded on Certificates. The interpretation of the grades is as follows :

### II. INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

The standard attained in Socially Useful Productive Work & Community Service, abbreviated on the face of the Certificate as SUPW & COMMUNITY SERVICE, is indicated by a letter grade, of which Grade A is the highest and Grade E the lowest. Only Grades A to D are recorded on Certificates. The interpretation of the grades is as follows :

#### Awards and conditions for awards

Provided that no candidate except as otherwise exempted by the Council, shall be awarded a Pass Certificate unless in addition to fulfilling the conditions above he has attained a pass grade in SUPW and Community Service as examined / assessed internally by the School.
