


DEED OF PARTNERSHIP



If there is any debit balance in the account of any partner interest at the same rate shall be payable by him.


8. That the profit & loss (if any) of partnership business shall be divided and borne by the partners as Follow:-



The remuneration so calculated shall be credited to Partners capital Account at the end of the year at the time of finalization of Accounts.

- 10. That the usual books of accounts shall be maintained by the firm at principal place as usually maintained by like other firm recording their transaction truly and faithfully.
- That the financial year of business shall be from 1st April To 31st March of each year and the accounts shall be closed on 31st March every year and the final accounts and Balance Sheet be drawn as the same period.
- 12. That a bank account shall be opened in firm name in any schedule bank and the same shall be operated by severally or Jointly by the partners.

That a Bank Account / Discharge of all legal and financial documents or any other similar liabilities generating will be executed by all the Partners.

- 13. That the partner shall be activity participating in day to day conduct and management of firm for the benefit of the Firm.
