



The Trust Deed of Right Path Foundation having its office at 102, Dropadi Kunj Apartment, New Patliputra Colony, Patna-800013 and registered as a Charitable Trust with the Registration Officer, District Registration Office, Patna (Bihar) under Indian Trust Act 1882 having Deed No. 1219, Volume No. 17, Page No. 115 to 129, C.D. No. 3, Dated 02/06/2008 (2nd day of June 2008) has been revised with consent of all the Trustees and settler.

As per consent of all the trustees and setter revisions are as follows:-

1. The objects for which this Trust is established are :

- i. To organize, conduct or promote any kind of work/programme/activity including establishing any type of institutions all over India or abroad for development & welfare of community members without discrimination of race, caste, creed, religion, region, sex, vocation or practices.
- ii. To open, establish, promote, set-up, maintain, support and/or help literacy, informal, formal and/or distance education programmes/ activities including technical/ non-technical, professional, management, teacher's training, art & craft, vocational and physical education/ training/ course by any or all types of schools, colleges, universities, training/ coaching centres, hostels, research institutions and all types of institutions including educational or others of the like nature for the purpose.
- iii. To open, establish, promote, set-up, maintain, plan, manage and/or run health care centres/clinics,





hospitals/nursing homes, nursing schools/ colleges (Medical, Dental, Ayurvedic, Homeopathic, Yunani, Tibbi and/or Siddha), charitable dispensaries, mobile dispensaries, pathological laboratories, maternity homes, child welfare centers, old age centres, convalescent homes, sanatoriums, and any type of institutions or centers for all types of preventive, promotive, curative and/or services on physical or mental health.

- To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aid to iv. institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music. drama and fine arts, for preservation, development and/or maintenance of monuments/remains/sites or area and for research and other institutions having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.
- To open, establish, promote, set-up, support, maintain ٧. and/or run community development programs/ activities and also construct/ develop, support, maintain and/or manage Community Halls, Rest Houses, Hostels, Marriage Homes, Dharamshalas, shelters, Day-care centres, Shauchalaya, Old Age Homes, Orphanage, Widow or Destitute Women Home, Libraries, Reading Rooms, Sports Clubs, Playgrounds, Recreational Parks, Stadiums (both open and indoor), Centers, Gymnasiums, Sangeetalyas Nrityalayas (music and dance training centers/theatres). Anganwaris, Balwaris, Mahila Ashrams, Studios, Drama, Stage and other buildings/institutions for use of General Public and for the welfare of the general public.
- vi. To establish, construct, maintain and/or aid Paths, Roads, Bridges, Parks, Gardens, Sewerages, Wells, Tube-wells, Water reservoirs, Community Market Centres, buildings/institutions or any infrastructure, which are used by the general public.
- vii. To take up effective, reasonable and lawful steps for the solution of the problems relating to the blind, deaf,


dumb, physically and mentally handicapped and/or other disabled persons for their psychiatric/ curative/ rehabilitative support or to provide them education, food, clothing or other help or for any programme/ activity to make them independent.

- viii. To give, provide and/or render monetary and/or other help and assistance for the relief of persons affected by natural and other calamities such as floods, fire, famines, cyclones, earth quakes, storms, accidents, pestilences, droughts and epidemics and/or give assistance to institutions, establishments or persons engaged in such relief work.
- ix. To collaborate, affiliate, federate and cooperate with any type of educational institutions, Universities, Research institutions/ laboratories, Government Bodies, CBOs and/ or National/International Agencies for implementing any programme of developmental nature.
- x. To take up effective, reasonable and lawful steps and conduct all kinds of programmes for eradication of social evils such as Dowry, Child Marriage (Bal Vivah), Female foeticide, Witch craft, Child Labour, and use of tobacco or intoxicating drugs/substance.
- xi. To establish, start, run, maintain, support and/or manage all types of community radio stations, FM radio stations, TV channels, audio/video studios and production houses.
- xii. To promote the interest of people on various social issues by making Audio- Visuals, Tele-films, TV-serials and Documentaries and to print, produce and prepare awareness generating kits like Posters, Pamphlet, Broachers, Booklets, Stickers, Badges, Pin- ups, Banners, Audio- Video Cassettes and/or CD/DVDs, Nukkad Nataks, Puppet Shows, Skits, etc.
- xiii. To print, publish and/or exhibit Books, Charts, Illustrations, Journals, Magazines, Periodicals, News Letters/News Papers and other publications in any

format/media, language and subject for diffusion of useful information and knowledge.

- xiv. To work for advancement/promotion of handicrafts, cottage and small industries through obtaining and providing infrastructural support, grants or loans, sell or purchase of products, establishment of shops/emporia, organization of exhibitions, seminars, workshops and work for welfare, education, health and social security of the crafts persons, artisans, home based workers and all persons or their family members involved in such work.
- xv. To work for the promotion, modernization and technical upgradation of agricultural activities and its diversity for income augmentation for the farmers and, make efforts for their welfare by implementing allied and innovative programmes.
- xvi. To make efforts for the development of entrepreneurship among the have-nots by providing thematic trainings, skill trainings, establishing training cum production centers for the purpose, and facilitating marketing including development of export channels.
- xvii. To run programmes for the social mobilizations of the weaker sections in general, and the women in particular, for their all round development/ empowerment taking advantage, interalia, of the government/ non-government institutional programmes/ services and finance.
- xviii. To establish and manage crèches, orphanages, transit homes, short stay homes, help lines and undertake activities for the improvement in the lives and living conditions of the slum dwellers, homeless persons, old age persons, street children, children without family ties for the children, adolescents and women or any person in difficult situation.
- xix. To implement programmes for promotion of youth activities and sports.



- xx. To work for the conservation of the environment, dissemination, use and promotion of traditional or modern, appropriate, eco-friendly, low cost technologies including the use of renewable and non-conventional energy sources and to control and reduce all types of pollution and environmental degradation.
- xxi. To undertake research, study and survey pertaining to contemporary or relevant issues and problems and to publish the reports and findings sharing the information.
- xxii. To institute and award scholarships, fellowships, stipends and grants-in-aid to persons or institutes for promotion of activities conducive to the objects of the Trust.
- xxiii. To receive financial and non-financial assistance from Govt. and any other legal entity or individual. To accept donations, grants, presents, gifts, and other offerings in the shape of moveable and/or immovable properties for the attainment of the aims and objects of the society.
- xxiv. To purchase, take on lease, hire or otherwise acquire properties, movable or immovable, rights and privileges all over the world, in the name of the Trust, which may be deemed necessary or convenient for the benefit of the Trust and to sell, lease, mortgage, dispose or otherwise deal with all or any part of the properties of the Trust.
- That the Trust fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contributions from time to time.
- 5. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust which shall be kept at the office of the Trust.
- 6. That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall have the following powers:
 - To open account or accounts in the name of the Trust,
 Trustees and / or Institutions run / conducted by the
 Trust with a Bank or Banks, Government/Non-

Government financial institution, to operate such accounts and to give instructions to such Bank/Banks/financial institution and to provide for opening and operation of such accounts by one or more authorized Trustees or by an agent appointed by Trustees.

- b. To seek and accept subscriptions, donations, contribution, grants, loans, gifts and bequests, in cash or kind, from any person(s), body of persons, firm, company, corporation, institution, Local, State or Central Government/Authority, with or without conditions.
- c. To accept or acquire by gift, purchase, exchange, lease or hire or otherwise lands, buildings, basements, playgrounds, parks and asset/property, movable or immovable, for or in the name of the Trust for the furtherance of any or all objects of the Trust.
- d. To negotiate with and enter into agreement, contract or arrangements with any Government/ Authority/ University/ College/ Institution(s) and/ or other Public or Private body or persons which may seem conducive to the promotion or accomplishment of the objects of the Trust and to apply, obtain, receive or recover from any of these such grants, allowances, rights, concessions and privileges as may seem desirable.
- e. To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust or the Trust Fund or accumulations thereto, property, movable or immovable, to any one or more of the objects of the Trust, as the Trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- f. To convert and deal with the Trust property and / or any investments for the time being.
- g. To invest the Trust Fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, stocks or debentures or other securities and investments, or indeposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person, and to alter, vary or transpose such

investments, from time to time at the discretion of the Trustees.

- To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security or interest.
- To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund, in any manner the Trustees may deem fit.
- j. To let out or lease out any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent or such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- k. To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust.
- I. To appoint one or more constituted attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested on them under these presents and from time to time remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint other or others in their place.
- m. To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or Managing Trustees otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.
- n. To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulation for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and / or running any institution and/or programme.
- To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public.

- p. To set apart and / or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund for any of objects of the Trust.
- q. To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organisations or Trusts which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institutions, societies, organizations or Trusts to start, maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- r. To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or dispute, claim, demand or thing, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- s. To borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- t. To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grants of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promote the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies, corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- u. To join, co-operate or amalgamate this Trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such

terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.

- v. To establish, promote, manage, organize or maintain or to assist in establishing promoting, managing, organizing, or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust in any part of India.
- w. To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- x. To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the Trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- y. To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the Trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- z. To transfer and hand over the Trust to any other Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization on such terms and conditions as the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to be held by the Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization with the powers, provisions, agreements and declaration, appearing and contained in these presents subject to such modifications as may be necessary and consequent to such transfer of the Trust fund. The Trustees for the time being of these presents shall become discharged from the Trust hereof relating to Trust Funds so transferred.



- 8. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts of omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor of any banker or other person with whom the Trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.
- 9. Ms. Rajni Kumari Singh D/o Shree Ram Singh, 102 Dropadi Kunj Apartment, New Patliputra Colony, Patna 800013 (Bihar) has become the Permanent Trustee in place of Ms. Akanksha, D/o. Shri Ramadhar Sharma, East Ashok Nagar, Road no. 148, Gali no. 4, Kankarbagh, Patna -800 020 (Bihar). Ms. Akanksha has resigned from the Trust and has no liability on the Trust. From now on, she will have no stake in the Trust or any of its programmes or activities whatsoever and cannot make any kind of claim on the Trust. First Trustee, Mr. Avijeet Kumar S/o Moh.— Udantpuri, Garhpar, PO-Biharsharif, Distt.- Nalanda (Bihar) will continue as Permanent Trustee and Trustee Chairman.
- 10. The Trustees named in this Deed will be the Permanent Trustees during their lifetime and each of them may nominate his / her successor to become the Permanent Trustee in his / her place. If Permanent Trustees fail to nominate his / her successor, all of his / her legal heirs will be his / her successor with equal rights.
- 11. The number of the Trustees shall not be less than two and more than five. If the number of the Trustees falls below two, the Trustee Chairman may appoint, as per his discretion, any suitable person as a Trustee. If the Trustee Chairman is not there, his legal heir may take the decision for appointment. The Permanent Trustees will be at liberty to appoint Co-opted Trustee whose number will not be more than three-for such period as the Permanent Trustees may consider proper. A person shall cease to be a Co-opted Trustee if he / she is requested

to resign by two-third or as near thereto as possible of the remaining Trustees.


- 12. The Trustee Chairman and other Trustees (including co-opted Trustees) will be entitled to receive remuneration, as decided from time to time, if they give their part/full time for work of this Trust. The amount theirto would be decided in the meeting of the Trustees. The Trustees may also reimburse all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
- 13. Any Co-opted Trustee may also be removed if he/she
 - a. becomes of unsound mind;
 - is convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than six months;
 - c. does not work/act according to objectives of the Trust and is found involved in malpractice harmful to the reputation of the Trust.
 - absents himself from three consecutive meetings of the Trust without prior permission of the Trustee Chairman.
 - e. is absent from India for a continuous period of more than six months without prior permission of the Trustee Chairman.
- 14. Every Trustee, including the Permanent Trustees, will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his/her intention to do so.
- 15. The Trustee Chairman will be the Chief Functionary of the Trust and will represent the Trust either personally or though a person authorized by him. Other Trustees shall exercise such powers and discharge such responsibilities as are delegated / assigned by the Trustee Chairman.
- 16. Meeting of trustees shall be conducted as per following rules and regulations:

- (a) Trustee Chairman will call the meeting of trustees by information/notice through letter, e-mail, telephone or messenger.
- (b) Trustees will normally meet two times in one Financial Year.
- (c) Trustee Chairman can any time call meeting of trustees for specific purpose.
- (d) Two Trustees shall form quorum for any meeting of the trustees.
- (e) Trustee Chairman can invite anybody in the meeting of trustees without the right to vote.
- (f) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees. If mutual decision is not arrived at, the decision of the Trustee Chairman will be final.
- (g) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two-thirds of the Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- 17. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.
- 18. The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year. The trustees shall arrange for the accounts to be audited annually by Charted Accountants within the meanings of the Chartered Accountants Act 1949, whom the Trustees may employ and pay for the purposes.
- 19. The Trust Deed may be modified/ revised as and when deemed fit and proper by the Trustee Chairman.



- 20. The Trustees may join, co-operate or amalgamate this Trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit.
- 21. The Trustees may, if they are of the opinion that the Trust be dissolved, by means of a majority resolution passed at a meeting of the Trustees may dissolve the Trust, and, if after all the debts and liabilities are paid or provided for there shall remain any assets, the same shall be transferred or donated to some other organization or association or Trust having aims and objects which in the opinion of the majority of the Trustees are similar to all or any of the Trust purposes set out in the Trust Deed.
